OWLS Program: Since OWLS kicked off on 7/2/08

There has been 29 weeks of OWLS radio segments on the radio with Pat Morrish. Approx 15minutes of air time & a Variety of agencies have assisted in presenting safety tips or advice for seniors in the community on this program. The weekly program will be modified slightly from September 2008 & become a talk back session where seniors can call for advice regarding a particular topic. This will be monitored through & continual assessments on the viability.

The \$450.00 million Cairns Hospital redevelopment is on track with work to begin as early as October 2008.

Some Issues:

CRC: Work relating to the slumping section of Swallow Street Drain is under construction with maintenance taking place to the section from McCoombe Street crossing to Moody Creek.

CRC: Discussions re: Swallow Street catchment of McCoombe & Swallow Sts crossing to allow water access for the full width of the drain.

Police: referral to unnecessary noise

CRC: Reported issues beside Swallow Street Drain, Access driveway hole, fill required on footpath, tree roots, tree stump.
