2011: Lions Club of Cairns Inc.: Currently working closely with the Australian National University, Canberra, on a project that is evaluating the preferences of Cairns residents for emergency services during and after cyclones. The Survey Program involves consultation with the Cairns Regional Council, Emergency Management Queensland, and Evacuation Centres. Because Lions members will be distributing and collecting the survey forms within the community in August I have played a key leadership role by steering the project through the Cairns Lions Club. The project results will be a great asset for Cairns and surrounding suburbs, and may well prove instrumental in obtaining additional funding for the area. Adjunct Associate Professor Leo Dobes of the Crawford School of Economics and Government at the ANU is aware of the work in the community and has expressed his full support.
