**CHINAMAN CREEK – PROPOSED PRUNING PROGRAM**

Cairns Regional Council has received requests from the local Neighbourhood Watch group and the Queensland Police Service regarding pruning of vegetation along Chinaman Creek between Marsh St and Downing St, Earlville.

It has been reported that this area is a safety issue for the community and is subject to crime activities and undesirable behaviour. Therefore to help improve visibility and safety in this vicinity, Council proposes to remove undergrowth from trees as shown in the attached map.

As part of this process, Council is required to apply for appropriate environmental permits through the Department of Environment and Resource Management.
